Monday, October 7, 2024

Location: Swiss Museum of Transport, Lucerne

We spend an exciting day at the Swiss Museum of Transport in Lucerne and can marvel at the numerous exhibitions on ships, trains and airplanes in small groups. With the various simulators, themed islands and original objects, we immerse ourselves in the moving history of transportation on water, on land, in the air and in space. In the afternoon, we can look forward to a journey to the stars in the planetarium. Of course, there is plenty of time to play in the large playground arena with the traffic garden and the bike course.

Tuesday, October 8, 2024

Location: Boda Borg, Rümlang

In the morning, it's off to Boda Borg in Rümlang, where children aged 7-13 can discover new treasure islands, explore mummy tombs or break out of a prison on various adventure missions. Solving puzzles always opens doors to new experiences....Fun guaranteed! Children aged 5-6 will have also a great time in the trampoline hall Flip Lab opposite Boda Borg. In the afternoon, we explore the three playrooms in the National Museum with the flying carpet.

Wednesday, October 9, 2024

Location: Environment Arena & Bowling

The Umwelt Arena in Spreitenbach awaits us with 45 interactive exhibitions on four floors. We learn why it is so important to use the earth's resources sustainably and how young and old can contribute to this. We can see our ecological footprint on the globe and try our hand at football penalty shoot-outs on a recyclable grass carpet. The children's course with special scooters and go-karts is also sure to be fun. Afterwards, we'll try to hit as many pins as possible on the bowling alley at Bowling West.

Thursday, October 10, 2024

Location: Skillspark, Winterthur

A day full of action awaits us at the Skillspark in Winterthur! In the huge multi-sports hall, every child can try out the various parks, whether they are beginners or experienced: Skatepark, Big-Air Park, Trampoline Park or the Pump Track guarantee lots of fun. Skateboards, scooters and like-a-bikes are available, but you can also bring your own. Various quiet zones or the indoor playground invite you to relax.

Friday, October 11, 2024

Location: Climbing hall Milandia & Mühlerama

The Milandia climbing hall offers the perfect combination of sport and play. We try our hand at bouldering, where we climb up the colorful climbing walls and land safely back on the ground. In addition to the climbing courses, there are also fun games of skill. Then it's back to Zurich, where we explore the Mühlerama with a flour brush. In the workshop, we can grind our own flour from grains and race down the grain slide!
