Program day trips from Lucerne/Zug from Monday, July 7 to Friday, July 11, 2025

Montag, July 7, 2025 Burgrain adventure farm in Alberswil

At Erlebnishof Burgrain in Alberswil, we can observe the animals and everyday life on the organic farm on a guided children's tour. Afterwards, we will bake little animals from yeast dough and let off steam in the playground. In the afternoon, a beekeeper will take us to the apiary, where we will learn about the important tasks of bees and how honey is made.

Tuesday, July 8, 2025 Treetop path on the Fräkmüntegg

We explore the Pilatus and walk through the treetop trail with twelve nests. We walk on wide walking ropes and well-secured nets and can get to know the forest and its inhabitants better in six of the twelve nests. After a barbecue, it's off to the playground in PILU-Land.

Wednesday, July 9, 2025 Lamatrekking in Giswil

We visit the llamas of the Ambauen family in Giswil and take a long walk with the llamas to a picnic area. There we can feed and stroke them and learn interesting facts about the species, husbandry and care of these animals from South America.

Thursday, July 10, 2025 Sack knife day on the Mueterschwandenberg

On the magical Mueterschwandenberg in the canton of Nidwalden, Priska and Flavian introduce us to the art of carving sack knives. After a refreshment of Älplermagronen, we will receive the final tips and tricks for our work with the sack knife. Afterwards, games await us in the forest and on the farm.

Friday, July 11, 2025 Goldau Zoo

At Goldau Zoo, we take plenty of time to observe the more than 100 species of wild animals such as wolves and bears. In the free-range area, we can pamper sika deer and mouflons with food cubes and cuddles, and marvel at the climbing skills of the ibex. Of course, there is plenty of time to let off steam in the nature playgrounds.
