Monday, July 7, 2025

Location: Monkey Town & Boat trip

Today we can really let off steam in the Monkey Town play paradise in Horgen! Slides, climbing mazes, tunnel systems and great trampolines await us. After so much exercise, fun and games, we will go on a leisurely boat trip on Lake Zurich after lunch. There, in addition to a puzzle game, a delicious snack awaits us.

Tuesday, July 8, 2025

Location: Höllgrotten Caves, Baar

The Lorentzobel near Baar offers us the ideal start today for exploring the unique stalactite caves in Baar. We can marvel at the Höllgrotten caves with their fairytale-like stone formations on a tour and let ourselves be carried away into a fabulous world. We discover the shaggy and fairytale grottoes as well as the wonderfully illuminated magic castle. After visiting this magical underground world, we enjoy a delicious lunch and spend the afternoon in the nature of the Lorentzobel.

Wednesday, July 9, 2025

Location: Glass blowing Hergiswil

Today we will go to the glass blowing at Hergiswil, where we will visit the museum "shaped by fire" and learn about the history of glass during a unique sound and light show. We get to watch the glassblowers at work as they shape, blow and cast glasses from the glowing mass. We will also be enchanted by the glass labyrinth as well as the outdoor glass-water games. In the playground we can look forward to the slide of the 7-meter-high marble run!

Thursday, July 10, 2025

Location: Museum of Transport, Lucerne

We spend an exciting day at the Swiss Museum of Transport in Lucerne and can marvel at the numerous exhibitions on ships, trains and airplanes in small groups. With the various simulators, themed islands and original objects, we immerse ourselves in the moving history of transportation on water, on land, in the air and in space. In the afternoon, we can look forward to a 3D show in the movie theater. Of course, there is also plenty of time to play in the large playground arena with the traffic garden and the bicycle course.

Friday, July 11, 2025

Location: Animal park Goldau

We take plenty of time in the Goldau Zoo to observe the more than 100 species of wild animals such as wolves and bears. In the free-range zone we can spoil the sika deer and mouflon with food cubes and caresses, and we marvel at the climbing skills of the ibex. A delicious lunch awaits us in the cosy Gans restaurant, so that we have enough energy to let off steam on the playgrounds afterwards.
